Animal Care Technician

The County of Yuba is currently recruiting for an Animal Care Technician position within the Animal Services Division of the Yuba County Sheriff's Department. Under general supervision, the Animal Care Technician assist in the daily maintenance, feeding and care of animals housed in the county's animal care facility including those subject to quarantine, injured or ill. Animal Care Technicians assist with euthanizations and dispose of animals in a humane and prescribed method, in accordance with established policies and California laws, provide information to the public regarding lost or stray animals, assist with licensing, pet adoptions and community volunteer programs, and perform related work as assigned.

Ideal Candidate:

The ideal candidate must have a willingness to handle aggressive, injured and dead animals in a variety of situations. This classification may work extended off-hours shifts or be called back in emergency situations. The incumbent must have a teamwork mentality but posses the ability to work independently when assigned.

Required Qualifications:

Minimum: Equivalent to graduation from high school and any experience in the care and handling of animals.

<u>**Preferred**</u>: In addition to the minimum requirements, additional experience in an animal care facility that required euthanasia. Possess a Registered Veterinary Technician License.

Working Conditions: Work evenings, nights, weekends, holiday extended hours, and rotating shifts. Willingness to handle ill, injured or dead animals in potentially hazardous situations.

Registered Veterinary Technicians encouraged to apply.
