- Six (6) months of experience working with school age children

### Physical Requirements:

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to stand, walk, use hands and fingers to handle or feel, bend, reach with hands and arms and talk or hear. The employee is occasionally required to sit, climb or balance, twist, stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl. The employee must occasionally carry and or lift up to 40 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and ability to adjust focus. Candidates should detail related education and experience on the application since this information will be used to determine who will be invited to participate in the next phase of the examination process. The examination process may include any or all of the following: application appraisal, written examination, oral board interview examination and/or performance examination. NOTE: Prior to appointment, candidate must pass a pre-placement physical examination, background check (including fingerprint "livescan" clearance) and submit transcripts to verify educational requirements.
