ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

Mill Valley Public Works includes the divisions of Engineering and Operations (Building, Parks, Streets and Sewers, and Fleet Maintenance). With the complement of approximately 32 staff, a \$8 million operational budget, and oversight of the \$45.5 million 5-year Capital Improvement Program, the department offers a full range of services and support for residents, businesses, and City departments.

ABOUT THE POSITION

Under general supervision, the Maintenance Worker II is assigned to the Streets Division of the Public Works Department and is responsible for performing a variety of skilled and semi- skilled tasks and operating power- driven road maintenance or construction equipment and trucks.
